MATE RIALS

TC1003A Coupe Dinner Plate 11 3/4
Liner Brush
Medium Brush
Pattern
NCR paper or tissue paper

COL ORS

CMM 22 - Gecko Green

CMM 105 - Storm

CMM 5 - Coral Reef

CMM 3 - Carnation

CMM 31 - Licorice

CMM 91 - Blue Ice

CMM 44 - Battleship




INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Trace on the dinosaur Pattern using either NCR paper or a tissue paper transferring technique before doing the prints so that you know where to place the hand.
- 2. Cover the child's hand using a brush and a heavy application of Coral Reef. Stamp the hand down as shown in the photo.
- 3. Trace on the mountains and volcano where desired.
- 4. Fill in the sky with one streaky coat of Blue Ice.
- 5. Fill in the mountains with 2 coats of either Storm or Battleship using a medium brush.
- 6. Next, create the grass by applying one coat of Gecko Green making small vertical tick marks to resemble grass.
- 7. Fill in the belly and the collar of the dinosaur with 2-3 coats of Carnation.
- 8. Next, fill in the remainder of the dinosaur with 3 coats of Coral Reef, working around the handprint. We are leaving the horns unpainted.
- 9. Use your liner brush to outline your dinosaur.
- 10. Finally Use your detail brush or a detail writing bottle to apply your words as well as the child's name and age.

TIPS

- Be generous with the paint to get the most even color.
- Even pressure on the liner brush will help you get an even line. You can also make a cute broken line to make it faster and more whimsical.
