

SPLATTER TREE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

CCX3120 9" Christmas Tree Fan Brush Medium Brush Liner Brush

COLORS

CMM 90 - Red Hot CMM 29 - Grasshopper CMM 8 - Basil CMM 27 - Kiwi



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start out by painting the tree with three coats of Kiwi using a fan brush. We want to be cautios not to fill in the holes with paint, you can use the stick end of a small paint brush to help open up those holes.
- 2. While the tree is drying we can paint the base. Use your medium brush to paint everything on the base except the bottom trim.
- 3. Paint the bottom trim using either a liner brush or medium brush with 3 coats of Grasshopper.
- 4. Water down both Grasshopper and Basil with 50% water to 50% paint. Working one color at a time, dip you brush into the watered down paint and run your finger over the bristles to splatter and spray the tree with the darker green colors.

TIPS

- The harder your press on your brush, the heavier the lines will be. So when you're making your outline, words, and branches, use very light pressure.
- Before you splatter, make sure to water down your colors.
- Three coats of paint will give you a solid color.
